A Valuable Opportunity to Cooperate

Women to Women Ministry Training is an inter-mission ministry designed to encourage, resource and equip missionary women living on the field. It is tailored to meet their specific needs by:



- appreciating the sacrifices women make to live in another culture and learn another language;
- understanding the benefit of ongoing personal enrichment and relationship, and how hard it can be to find;
- realizing that ministry needs become apparent after spending time on the field, and that the missionary is usually not prepared for this;
- recognizing that women cannot usually leave the field to get the training they need, and so need opportunities they can access geographically; and
- valuing the wider network of missionary women in a geographic area to multiply their efforts and resources together.

A Meaningful Hope to Pursue

Women to Women Ministry Training offers:

- personal and spiritual refreshment through friendship with other missionaries around God's Word;
- regular, ongoing, face-to-face interactions for stimulation and nurture in our circumstances; and
- discovery and affirmation of gifting and abilities with growth in confidence to exercise them.
