Objective

Older women are likewise to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips, nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good, that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, that the Word of God may not be dishonored.

Process

- ☞ facilitated discussion and practical assignments from a curriculum designed for women by women
- ☞ discovery and development of spiritual gifts and God-given hopes
- ☞ developing appropriate models of ministry for women in their own churches and areas of need
- ☞ envisioning in the sharing of resources and experience for wider Kingdom benefit

WWLT training experiences speak deliberately to the needs and perspectives of women, helping them to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ, with each other, and with those in their sphere of influence, as well as grow in godly hope and confidence as they serve the body of Christ creatively, effectively, enthusiastically and humbly.



Curriculum

Ministry Basics: Facilitating Relational Learning

Provides transforming perspectives and skills toward good adult education practices that are essential to effective small group discipleship and multiplication ministry.

Walking with Christ

Lays the foundation for a dynamic life-long walk with Christ in grace and truth.

Developing a Discerning Heart

Covers how to recognize and cooperate with the ongoing, deepening work of God's Spirit in the life of the disciple, so that she can then more effectively help others trust and experience God as they navigate the challenges of life.

Discovery Bible Study

Teaches how to effectively study the Bible in order to enhance biblical understanding for self and others, enrich personal devotions, lead small group discussions, and prepare lessons and messages.

Evangelism and Discipleship

Covers how to become a disciple and a disciple-maker—a defining privilege and joy in the life of a believer.

Women Serving Women

Identifies needs, gifts, challenges and opportunities in creating and sustaining meaningful ministry to women through the local church.

Other courses or segments may be added in response to specific needs in a given training situation.
