After gathering up a folder full of documents and Greek translations, Sandi & I went to the local government office on Thursday to turn in our applications but were told that we can only do that on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday between 10:15 and 11:30!

. . . that we will be able to turn in our residence permit applications next week without further hassle and that our new documents will be issued before our current ones run out in November.

. . . for strength and safety as we move to the new apartment by the end of this month and that we will be able to get settled quickly.

. . . for the upcoming "seeker" evangelistic evening on Sunday, October 4.

. . . for the next diplomatic breakfast on October 13.

. . . for my Bible teaching and personal mentoring ministry to refugees from the Middle East.

#### INVESTING IN OUR MINISTRY

Sandi & don't like talking about money but need to let you know that we are facing a serious, ongoing financial crunch that continues to make it a challenge to "not be anxious about anything." Several of our most faithful support partners have died or retired in the past year, and others have lost their jobs. We received a warning from the Entrust home office that our account had fallen to **negative** \$1,465 the end of August. So, unless we receive some major gifts in the next 11 days we will not receive a full paycheck at the end of this month. To add stress to our current financial situation, the US Dollar has continued to drop in value against the Euro, and our upcoming move requires us to pay a **two month deposit and one month realtor fee plus the first month's rent up front!**
